**SPECIAL MEETING
March 23, 2011**

Vice-President Alan Ilgen called a properly advertised special meeting of the Millheim Borough Council to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following persons in attendance: Kay Brown, Marlene Corl, Alan Ilgen, Tom Strebel, Lauralee Snyder, Sharon Heckman, Todd Wasson and Carl Rote

Absent: Linn Auman and John R. Miller, III

Vice-President Ilgen dispensed with Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Vice-President Ilgen opened the meeting with the following statement: Millheim Borough Council held an Executive Session on Tuesday, March 15, 2011 from 6:59-8:04 p.m. to discuss matters of employment. As a result of that discussion, a second Executive Session, that included Todd Wasson, was held on Wednesday, March 16, 2011 from 6:53-7:12 p.m. to discuss matters of employment. As a result of Mr. Wasson's decision, this properly advertised Special Meeting is being held.

Vice-President Ilgen explained the purpose of this meeting is the termination of Todd Wasson from his position as Borough Employee. He then asked Mr. Wasson if he had anything he would like to say to Council. Mr. Wasson stated he had nothing to say at this time. A motion was made by Tom Strebel and seconded by Marlene Corl to terminate Todd Wasson from his position as the Borough employee. Motion carried unanimously.

Vice-President Ilgen told Mr. Wasson that he was to turn in all Borough keys, gas card, equipment and clothes with the Millheim Borough name. Mr. Wasson explained that he doesn't have a gas card.

Mayor Snyder explained that Gregg Township is requesting a letter of support from the Borough to be included in their grant request for a feasibility study for rails-to-trails in Penns Valley. A letter of support was done some time ago but a more current one is needed. She explained that they are meeting with landowners on a one-on-one basis. A motion was made by Tom Strebel and seconded by Kay Brown to send a letter in support of this study. Motion carried.

Tom Strebel stated that the handicap ramp was not shoveled and a back up plan is needed to cover this.

A motion was made by Tom Strebel and seconded by Kay Brown to adjourn the meeting at 7:08 p.m. Motion carried.
